

Tentative program for Nordic Arboretum Committee meeting 2020

The Nordic Arboretum Committee

Arboretum have many purposes and are involved in education, conservation, promotion of species, tourism and science. The Nordic Arboretum Committee is a forum for exchange between small and large tree collections, public and private, professional and amateur that aims to inspire managers and the various users to make better use of their collections. The core participants in the network come from Iceland, Norway, Sweden, Finland and Denmark but with participation from neighboring countries. The network organizes regular meetings and joint activities, such as collection travels.

The 2020 meeting will be held August 3-7 in Denmark

The 2020 meeting will be organized as a two-day workshop in the Hørsholm Arboretum north of Copenhagen, followed by a three-day field trip to tree collections and forests in Jutland (Western Denmark).

The workshop is entitled "The future for tree collections" and the principle aim is to facilitate exchange of knowledge between participants and to provide inspiration for how to improve the use of our valuable collections. We invite participants to make shorter or longer presentations related to their collections, for example by presenting aims and management of the collections, or by sharing important results. We hope to be able to invite two speakers to talk on central aspects in relation to Arboretum.

The field trip in 2020 will focus on Jylland, as the previous trip in 2010 was dealing with Sjælland. We will visit Denmark's tallest trees, a famous natural forest and various botanical (tree) collections.
